PADDLERS

1. Slow Down, Reduce Your Wake[100' above & below anglers]
2. Ask Which Side To Pass On [after dark, look for a light that will direct you to correct side]
3. Be Aware That Fisherman Can't Hear – OR – Move Very Well in Moving Waters
4. After Dark, Please Use A Small Red Light So Fishermen Know You Are There
5. Please do not move or cut any wood or debris in the river, it is in many cases providing trout habitat. The liveries ensure the river is navigable.
6. Do not use privately owned docks without permission.
7. Do not trespass on private property to use or leave the river.

6th Annual Onaway Canoe Race

Exact same course and times as last year

C-1 race Saturday evening May 12th, 5:30 pm ---Begins at Kleber Dam on Kleber Pond (Kleber Dam Rd.). It's a looped course, predominantly a pond race. Finishing time between 40 and 80 minutes.

C-2 pro race (expert and div. II) Sunday May 13th, 10:30 am --- Begins and ends at the Tower Pond boat ramp behind the softball field and fire hall on M-68 in Tower. 4 portages with the longest being about 200 yards. Race time will vary from 1:45 - 2:30.

There will be pick-up boats on the ponds for turnovers due to boat wakes at the start.

There will be a banquet after the race on Sunday at the fire hall. Unlike past years, this meal will cost a nominal \$5. This meal is provided by Onaway High School's class of 2008. They will earn all the profits from the meal so please plan on attending what should be a good meal for a charitable cause.

USCA Winter Meeting Highlights

The USCA has added 3 new classes C-1 & C-2 stock in men's and women's to be run with the Cruisin Class. This class will be a Demo Class a stock boat is one that is off the rack with not concave lines. Also a C-1 unlimited class, can use a rudder with a single blade paddle. This is to be run on Wednesday as is the Demo class during Nationals. They dropped the outrigger class except for adaptive paddler. Also next winters meeting other classes will be looked at and will be dropped if they do not have enough participation. They changed the sea kayak from day 2 to day 1 with a special award for the 1st K-2 mixed.

Nationals 2008 will be in Bristol IN and Matt Streib will be the host. The races will start in Mottville and end in Bristol town park. The Aluminum Nationals will be in Texas in '08. Nationals '09 dates are Aug. 11-16.

Also USCA insurance will remain at \$4.50 but they will offer a reduced rate of \$4 for a list of names of who entered the race, so the USCA can send membership forms to those who are not members. They will not sell the list to anyone.
